GRADUATE SCHEME

We need graduates of the highest calibre to become our future leaders. In exchange for your hard work and commitment, we will support you with a top quality graduate training programme to ensure you build a construction career with strong foundations.

Participants will be recruited as graduates into specific functions. Such as (but not limited to) quantity surveying or site management and will complete a structured 6 week induction to the business before focussing on their role.

During the two year programme, you will spend most of your time in your home department but also spend 6 week placements in broader business departments (site operations, commercial, technical, business development just to name a few) to gain an insight into the wider business. In addition, you will attend programmed days in an around the business.

Whilst the technical skills for your chosen career are important, we know that the most successful graduates are those that are well rounded. That is why we include

the Institute of Leadership and Management's Level 2 Award in Team Leading in our graduate scheme. This will give you a solid introduction to the skills needed to lead people and teams. We will also fully fund and support you in gaining full membership of the relevant professional body such as RICS or CIOB.

At the end of the two years you will conclude your time as a Graduate and will be appointed into a role.

The graduate salary is £20k per annum, with a £2k London weighting.

YEAR-OUT PLACEMENTS

Lovell provides placement opportunities for undergraduates who have a year-out in the construction industry as part of their degree course. Placements are 10 months long, from the beginning of September to the end of June.

You will undertake a structured programme in our business that meets the requirements of your course and gives a meaningful overview of the industry and Lovell. Clear objectives will be set and agreed with your line manager and you will follow a customised programme.

This ensures that we understand your expectations and your needs to fulfil the sandwich element of your course. You will gain an excellent insight into the construction industry during your time with us.

Once you have completed your year-out with us, we will help you make the most of your final year at university and help you achieve the best degree you can. There's a good chance of a job with Lovell when you leave university.

Year-out students will be paid a salary of £14k per annum.

LOVELL SCHOLARSHIPS

Lovell actively participates in the Scholarship programme. Lovell Scholarships are offered to students before they start their undergraduate studies and support students in construction related degree courses with bursaries and work experience.

The Scholarship features:

- £2,000 per year bursary funded by Lovell, paid in two equal instalments in September and March.
- Two 8 week work placements with Lovell in the summer after the first and second years.
 The placements are paid at the per annum equivalent of £14,000 which is approximately £270 per week before tax.
- Opportunities for additional unpaid work experience and to work with Lovell staff whilst conducting research for coursework.

- An induction day in the September before the first term and review days every six months thereafter.
- Potential for a Year-Out
 Placement with Lovell in the sandwich year if applicable.
- The opportunity for you to leave university with an outstanding and much sought after degree, and reduced debt.
- A good chance of a job with Lovell when you leave university.

This Lovell Scholarship is available for bright, motivated and ambitious students, who show the potential to succeed in the construction industry.

Please note that the Scholarship is only open to UK Citizens for a first time degree and to those with a predicted minimum of 280 UCAS points.
